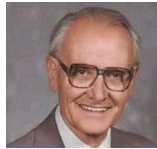

The Cap Paciotti Memorial Golf Tournament will be held at the Alexandria Golf Club on June 15, 2013 at 1:00 pm. Once again our major sponsors this year are State Bank & Trust and CDI.

CAF Contributions

They include uniforms for Boys Hockey, Girls Volleyball, and Boys & Girls Basketball. Other capital purchases include the scoreboard at Girls Softball, scoreboard at Discovery for Girls & Boys Swimming, and a trailer for team travel.

ACAF to Provide \$100,000 to New High School

The Alexandria Cardinal Athletic Foundation has pledged \$100,000 to be paid by December 2014 for three athletic facility projects at the new Alexandria Area High School. The first project is for installing Field Turf at the football/soccer stadium. The artificial turf at the stadium provides functional and economic benefits. Turf allows the field to be used year-round for practices, football and soccer games, and community events. In addition this will allow Alexandria to host MSHSL playoff games which should be a plus for the local economy. Ongoing savings will be seen by the school district due to the reduction of mowing, fertilizing, and irrigating the field.

The second project will increase the size of the gymnasium beyond the original plan approved by voters. This will provide more space between courts, bleachers, and walls. It will also provide seating for the 9th grade and B-squad games with seating on both sides of the court. The additional space will increase the flexibility to accommodate more events and tournaments.

The third phase of the pledge is to assist with building the tennis facility. This will include 12 tennis courts which would be sufficient to host school and community tennis events. It will allow our varsity and JV teams to play at the same site. These courts would be available for Cardinal tennis teams, students, and community.
